

## Step Number 5 We Are Sent!

“We Are Sent” is the last stop that this liturgy bus will make. Today, we receive a blessing or two and then we are sent into the world as God’s people.

### **Benediction**

We are getting near the end of the service. The pastor says, “The Lord bless you and keep. The Lord’s face shine upon you and be gracious unto you. The Lord look upon you with favor, and give you peace.” The only response that we can possibly say to that is... “AMEN!” So be it!

### **Sending Song**

This is the last hymn that we sing. It usually is a happy tune that summarizes what God has done in our lives through Jesus.

Sometimes this last hymn gets stuck in our heads, or at least the melody, so we get into our cars and head home with the tune stuck in our heads. That’s a great thing!

### **Sending**

The very last thing we say is “Go in peace, serve the Lord”. This simple message sends us out to serve the Lord because we have experienced God’s peace and forgiveness during the service. That should be shared with the world!
